These are some of the ways we can help:

Equipment Loaning- We can deliver sanitized equipment safely (contact-free) and provide support for set-up and ongoing training. (Computers/laptops are the responsibility of the school district.)

Curricula Adaptation & Customization- We can adapt your district's curriculum to meet the individualized needs of the student. We can also make visual supports, choice boards and social stories.

Drop-ins- We can participate in virtual or in-person drop-in sessions to provide coaching, modeling, and to make recommendations.

Reinforcement Sessions- We can help students engage in their schoolwork, increase their motivation and define clear expectations. We can also support students/parents in understanding the IEP, how to create routines and schedules, and provide support to complete academic requirements.

Joint Meetings- We can participate in meetings with school staff and parents/caregivers to promote consistency in school and at home.

Community Access & Travel Training- We can deliver customized training to help students safely access their community by walking, biking, public transportation, and ride sharing services or tutoring to obtain their temporary driving permit.

Employment Supports- We can help students access hundreds of businesses in their community for career exploration, volunteer experience or competitive employment.
