The Cuyahoga County Board of DD's Behavioral Health Department has a limited capacity for taking in graduate level field placements in the areas of social work*, counseling, and psychology. All placements are unpaid and are subject to availability of supervisors, the assessed fit between the student's educational needs and the experiences available, and completion of necessary paperwork prior to formal acceptance. The number of annual slots vary and will typically range from 0 – 5. Please note that the behavioral health field placements are for those who are primarily interested in behavioral or mental health-related work with individuals or groups of individuals receiving services.
