



ANNUAL TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFIED HPC PROVIDERS:

AT LEAST 8 HOURS OF TRAINING THAT ENHANCES THE SKILLS OF THE PROVIDER IS REQUIRED ANNUALLY.

The following topics are required annually:

- ✓ Incidents Adversely Affecting Health and Safety (MUI)
- ✓ Individual Rights, Person-centered planning, Community integration, Self-Determination, Self-advocacy, Positive intervention culture and Role of the Provider in Behavior Support.

INFORMAL TRAINING:

Providers may also obtain additional training hours through video and audio-visual training, staff meetings, lectures, seminars, formal coursework, workshops, conferences, demonstrations, visitations or observations of other facilities/services/programs, distance and other means of electronic learning.

The provider shall maintain a written record of training. Documentation must include the name of the person receiving the training, date of training, training topic, duration of training, instructor's name if applicable, and a brief description of the training.
